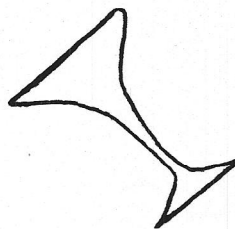
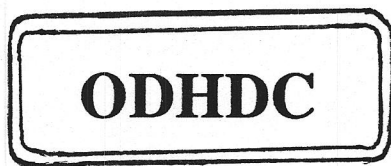

General Instructions

Welcome to our annual event that over the years has tested the ability of some and the patience of others. We are pleased that you have chosen to participate, either hungover or not, in today's event and hope that you will find it entertaining.

ODHDC was founded to preserve and protect those drivers who survived driving in and out of the city during rush hour on the Outer Drive (a feat that most don't live to tell about). This group is dedicated to the premise that creative cheating is encouraged during this rally, but normal, mundane cheating will be penalized. The Committee Odious reserves the right to make an arbitrary decision on this point.

The theme of today's rally is high schools in the city of Chicago (you may have even attended one of them). You will be given several pages of locations with questions whose answers will be found at or near the location. Each of the 66 locations will list the name of the school, address and question (in that order). Unless otherwise indicated in the question, all answers will be located on the side of the building given in the address. You will sometimes have to leave your car to find the question's answer, but we tried not to have this occur when in questionable neighborhoods (some schools were deleted from the list because of this).

Your answers (correct spelling is important) should be written on the official answer sheet next to the appropriate question number. Question point values are indicated on your answer sheet in parenthesis. No penalty for incorrect or omitted answers, two part questions must be answered fully. A tie-breaker question is included, but will be used only to break a tie, if necessary.

In cases of dispute, the decision of the judges is final, unless the Committee Odious feels like changing their minds. Awards will be presented after we figure out what to do with the answer sheets. The rallymasters will be available at the Start and Finish points but may or may not clarify any questions you might ask.

Beginning at 1:00 pm, you will be given a list of INSTRUCTIONS (locations where the associated questions can be answered) and an OFFICIAL ANSWER SHEET. You will have three hours to get as many answers as possible. At or before 3:30 pm, you will be required to hand in your answer sheet to the Official Scoring Committee at the finish point (in the restaurant) -DICK'S LAST RESORT, 435 E. ILLINOIS in Chicago. No answer sheets will be accepted after 4:00 pm, 1-1-90. Ten (10) point penalty for every minute after 3:30 pm.

The most coveted award of this rally is the "HERO OF THE YEAR" award. If you desire to nominate someone for this award, write a paragraph or two on a separate sheet of paper and turn it in to the Official Scoring Committee with your answers.

BONUS ITEMS - Points will be awarded for any of the following items turned in at REGISTRATION before 12:45 pm on 1-1-90. These items will be returned to you.
