4. The newly opened Hotel EMC2 at 228 E Ontario features two robot butlers, Cleo and Leo, who independently roam the property, delivering items such as towels and toothbrushes to guests. What less robotic animal sits guard out front?

5. Outside Hotel Felix, 111 W Huron, you'll find a few sculptures that could pass as robots, especially if you were desperate to find some more robot questions. What's the name of the dog?

Cheese

6. The Great American Cheese Collection, 1400 W 46th St, represents family and co-op cheese producers and is America's largest source for artisan cheese. According to the signs posted by the brewery also located in this structure, what must be done before loading and unloading?

On the northwest corner, what four letters can you find on a wall?

14. WTTW Studios, 5400 N St Louis, is Chicago's Public Broadcasting Service Station. Entering the parking lot, which entrances are wheelchair accessible?

15. A Netflix Original Series, Easy, filmed an episode of its show in Chicago's Beverly neighborhood. The episode was hilariously about package thieves and the neighbors essentially forming a neighborhood watch that got out of control quickly. The episode was filled in between 100th and 101st South Seeley. What direction of traffic is Seeley?

Public Art

16. Found at 1001 N Wolcott, a piece of metal sits atop a piece of sandstone pedestal, like a classical Grecian bust, and slowly dribbles water into a shallow basin. What is the name of this fountain?

17. Recently completed, the Great Wall of Chicago mural located at 8700 S Vincennes depicts many strong and positive images of Chicago for the Auburn Gresham neighborhood. What is the height restriction to pass under the bridge between the two sections of this mural?

18. Tom Friedman's Looking Up, also known as The Silver Man, was installed in 2015. He has dazzled bike riders and drivers alike since his installation. He is made of crushed aluminum foil, baking pans, and roasting pans. What direction is the body of Looking Up facing at Lake Shore Drive and 47th street (ish)?

19. Composed of thousands of inlaid chips in over 250 vibrant colors, Marc Chagall's beloved mosaic, The Four Seasons, was created for and given as a gift to the people of Chicago. It's located in the Chase Tower Plaza. Though it's official address is 10 S Dearborn, you're going to need to swing around to Monroe and let us know what's in the center of the clock in the plaza.

20. *The Great Migration Sculpture Garden* is home of the *Bronzeville Solar Spotlight* located at 446 E 47th Street. Please draw three images found on the south facing "wall" of this sculpture.

Outdoor Activities

21. Near Montrose Beach, you'll find the Montrose Point Bird Sanctuary, a welcome stop for many migrating birds. To get there, follow Montrose east, then turn right onto Montrose Harbor Drive. The sanctuary is the wooded and fenced area. When is parking reserved for Montrose volunteers?

22. Located at 2430 N Cannon Drive, the Peggy Notebaert Nature Museum is a great way to enjoy the outdoors without actually being outside. How many flag poles are outside the entrance?

23. Sure, it was controversial when then-Mayor Richard M Daley snuck bulldozers out in the middle of the night to tear up the runway at Meigs Field, but now we've got a great park in Northerly Island (just like he'd planned all a high five before they leave the lot.

24. The 606, or the Bloomingdale Trail, is a 2.7 mile long section of repurposed elevated train track that was turned into a linear park in 2016. The eastern end is at Walsh Park. 27. Trading and selling new and used books to all ages for 29 years, Bookies recently changed locations to a double storefront located at 10324 S Western Ave. According to the paper sign on the door, when will trade-ins/book donations resume?

28. 57th Street Books, at 1301 E 57th, is a quirky spot in Hyde Park, that is a favorite of the locals. One of their popular offerings is story time. When is Spanish storytime?

29. Open Books is a community organization that offers literacy programming and free books to Chicago youth. They've been so successful that they were recently able to open a second location at 905 W 19th St. You'll see their logo on the building - what are the letters "E", "N", "K", and "S" made out of?

30. Printers' Row seems like an obvious choice to go for books; however there's only one bookseller there. Luckily, Sandmeyer's at 714 S Dearborn is a great choice. What name is written above the entrance?

The Fugitive

31. There are a lot of great movies set in Chicago, but only one made this list. In the Fugitive, Harrison Ford plays Dr. Richard Kimble, and the story starts with a murder in his home at 336 W Wisconsin. What shape is the silver mailbox?

32. After escaping during a train wreck, Dr. Kimble heads back to Chicago to find the real killer. Needing a place to stay, he rents an apartment located at 9000 S Houston. Whose name can be found on the mailbox?

33. Kimble knows a one-arm man killed his wife because he fought the man. So, he tries to track him down by going to the prosthetics and orthotics wing at Cook County Hospital. This is now the Old Cook County Hospital at 1835 W Harrison; who is in charge of the construction for this building?

34. Frederick Sykes, the movie's hired killer, lives at 11217 S. St Lawrence. What is chained to the front porch?

35. Spoiler Alert! As the movie winds to a close, Kimble learns that Sykes was hired to kill him, and not his wife, by his friend, Dr. Charles Nichols to help cover up his involvement in releasing an unsafe pharmaceutical. 38. Inhale slowly... exhale softly. Since 2006, Beverly Yoga Center has operated as the only studio in the neighborhood, offering the community a retreat from the stresses of everyday life. According to the sign at street level, who should be contacted for rent inquiries within this building, located at 1917 W 103rd St?

39. At Yoga For All Beings, 508 N Hoyne, instructors will guide all levels of participants through a variety of classes and welcome you with open arms, happy hearts, and big smiles. What's painted on the building across the street?

44. The Chicago Tribune crossword is a classic, especially the Sunday edition. Tribune Tower, at 435 N Michigan Ave, is mostly blocked by construction protection, but you can still get to the entrance. What does it say above the revolving doors?

45. In 2002, a shaman investigated the alley behind 1139 W Fulton Market and confirmed the presence of an energy vortex. If you enter the alley behind May, you'll see a sign directing you to the vortex, which is located behind Mars Gallery. How many steps lead up to their loading dock?

Plants

47. Gethsemane Garden Center, at 5739 N Clark, may be the largest garden store in Chicagoit's certainly one of the most well known. What's the parking zone number on the street in front of the parking lot?

Circus

56. At the Aloft performing arts school in a historic church located at the corner of N Kimball and W Wrightwood, students learn clowning, trapeze flying and more with a BYOB performance occuring on the first Saturday of each month. What color are the doors of this building?

57. The MSA and Circus Arts is a Not-For-Profit Public Charity that supports and develops amateur athletes for national and international Sports Acrobatics and Circus competitions. The practice gymnasium is located at the corner of Campbell and Homer. How many windows are covered with shutters on the Homer side of the building?

58. The Universoul Circus is a summer fest held in Washington Park. While the circus takes up a large part of the 52nd street park corridor, our question is at 52nd and Payne Dr. What is displayed in "solo cups" on the baseball diamonds fences?

59. Located at 4730 N Sheridan, CircEsteem was founded by a retired Ringling Brothers & Barnum and Bailey clown and uses circus arts to promote self-esteem, coordination, teamwork, and learning to Chicago area youth. What word is written in blue on the colorful mural above their door?

60. The Trapeze School of New York: Chicago, at 5200 Lake Shore Drive seems to be closed up for the winter- we're assuming that's what the shipping containers in the parking lot at Foster are for. How many containers are there?

Chicago Food

61. You can't talk about Chicago food without mentioning pizza, and Giordano's is a deep dish king in this city. How much is parking at the 815 W Van Buren location?

62. Donuts are so trendy right now, and Suzy's favorites can be found at Doughnut Vault. They're hidden inside of the building at 111 N Canal- check the sign to the left of the doors and tell us who the third tenant on the list is.

63. Enoteca Roma knows that they've got some delicious Italian food- the website they share with their sister bakery is named superyummy.com. You probably don't have time to stop in for a meal at 2146 W Division street, but what color is the winter door/ awning?

64. It's a little chilly to enjoy the rooftop deck and restaurant at Gene's Sausage Shop, 4750 N Lincoln, but the organizers aren't opposed to a bribe from the store inside. What newspaper box will you find out front?

65. Kuma's Corner, at 2900 W Belmont, has arguably Chicago's best burger. Wheat two beers are advertised in the windows on Belmont?

Chicago History

66. A great start for learning about Chicago History, unsurprisingly, is the Chicago History Museum. Who is the pavillion to the left of the entrance at 1601 N Clark named for?

67. On the morning of December 4, 1969, police raided a Black Panther property at 2337 W Monroe, killing Fred Hampton and Mark Clark and setting off shock waves around the nation. What is the permit for the handicap parking zone in front?

68. **Chicago**'s Field Museum of Natural **History** (McFetridge, between Lake Shore Drive and Museum Campus Drive) has both of the words of this category in the title, and is anyone even really reading these tidbits, anyway? Please tell us what exhibitions are advertised over the South Door and also answer the question we just asked.

69. Statue of the Republic, also known as the Golden Lady, is a smaller-scale replica constructed in 1918 to commemorate the 25th anniversary of the World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago, where the original statue was. It also commemorates the Illinois statehood centennial. The statue can be found in between the Jackson park Golf Course, South Shore Yacht Club and Jackson Park Wood Island. 70. On May 4, 1886, a labor protest rally near Chicago's Haymarket Square turned into a riot after someone threw a bomb at police. The event would go on to become one of the key moments in the labor movement. There's now a memorial commemorating this at 151 N Desplaines - how many figures can you count on the sculpture?

Higher Learning

71. The Northwestern University Bookstore Chicago campus is located at 710 N Lake Shore Drive. What is not allowed in the building?

72. Presumably, students at the Illinois Institute of Technology spend a lot of time caffinating. What is the six number parking zone for Starbucks at 11 W 35th Chicago, IL?

73. The University of Chicago campus is expansive and expensive! The Booth School - Chicago is located at 5807 S Woodlawn Ave. Whose name is on the building?

74. When Katy went to UIC, it looked like a fallout shelter. Now that she's gone, they're of course building new buildings that actually look nice and welcoming. What color is the structure that is currently at Taylor and Morgan?

75. If a four-year university isn't for you, Chicago still has plenty of options. Without finding all the amazing trade schools in the Chicago area (Kendall cooking college, DeVry College, Electrical Line Worker College etc.) one would be remiss to not mention our police and fire. Chicago's Fire Academy is located at 1010 S Clinton, what is the slogan for the Survive Alive House?

Live Music

76. We love The Hideout! This prohibition-era bar is the only "house" located on the 1300 N. block of West Wabansia. While events are held nightly, this small space also acts as a dance and live music venue on weekends. How many windows are found on the bar's front door?

77. Designed as an opera house in 1892, Pilsen's Thalia Hall has been renovated and reopened in 2013 with three new concepts to fit the public's needs: a beer inspired restaurant, a cocktail bar and a public hall fit for all types of events. What can be found written in gold font on the West side of the building located at 1807 S Allport Street?

78. Jazz plays nightly at the Green Mill, 4802 N Broadway. There's only one sign in their window- what does it say?

79. The Jay Pritzker Pavilion at Millennium Park is a great place to catch a great band, all while sitting on a lawn and picnicking. We're not going to make you park and walk there, so head to the back side of the pavillion, at 205 E Randolph, which houses the Harris Theater for Music and Dance. Just to the west, you'll find the Millenium Park Welcome Center. According to their door, where is the parking garage?

80. Housed in an old Schlitz brewery, Schuba's Tavern offers nightly music at Southport and Belmont. On the north (Belmont) side of the building is a historic marker, and to the left of that, a yellow sign. What are drivers instructed to do?

Puppies

81. PAWS, at 1997 N Clybourn, is a great place to get a new best friend (they have cats, too, if you're into that). Who is their adoption center named for?

82. Even on a cold winter day, you'll find plenty of puppies having the best time at the Montrose Dog Beach. To get there, you'll follow Wilson Avenue until it curves to the left at the lake. To get to the park, drive through the Museum of Science and Industry's South Lot, which is at 1800 Columbia Drive. Drive by Museum Shores Yacht Club - Jackson Bark is at the end. Before you get there, you'll pass a trailhead on the south side. What is the name of the meadow?

85. There's an incredible mural of many dogs at the Logan Square Dog Park, located at Artesian and Logan. As you approach the mural heading east on Logan and turning onto Artesian, what color is the only non-dog animal in the first full panel?
